## A Place of Welcome

The Hospitality Center is a program of Catholic Charities that provides a hearty meal seven days a week, 365 days a year to those without adequate means to feed themselves. The daily meal is served in a peaceful atmosphere where guests are treated with respect and dignity.

There is no cost or fee for receiving a meal at the Hospitality Center.



## Volunteering

Volunteers are the heart and soul of the Hospitality Center. They are the key to keeping the Center open. Volunteers are needed to facilitate every aspect of the Hospitality Center, such as:

- Cooking
- Serving meals
- Welcoming guests
- Driving to pickup food donations
- Cleaning
- Maintenance and repairs

## Needed Support

The majority of funding for the Hospitality Center comes from individuals, foundations and agency fundraisers. The Hospitality Center also relies heavily on in-kind donations of goods and services from local businesses and citizens. The Center needs this community support to serve more than 40,000 meals a year and fulfill its mission of minimizing the impact of hunger upon the poor.

## Filling a Plate and Fueling a Life

Those who are regularly hungry face obstacles other than an empty stomach. Persistent hunger is a life altering condition that affects how adults function as workers and parents, how children perform at school and how people view their communities and their lives. The Hospitality Center exists as a resource to address the obstacle of hunger, so that lives can be richer and more productive.

To help it combat hunger, the Center is always open to receiving donations of the following items:

- Silver ware
- Cleaning supplies
- Cash

All persons have the right to be treated with dignity and respect.
